

Conservation Futures

Seeking project proposals from Nillumbik Landcare group members

Conservation Futures is a three year project, led by the Nillumbik Shire Council, with project partners including the Nillumbik Landcare Network. This project focusses on on-ground works to assist in the conservation of nine key threatened species in Nillumbik and surroundings. This project works with public and private land managers and an allocation of the budget is to assist the Nillumbik Landcare Network with threatened species conservation works. Each year for the next three financial years, the project will be able to assist with fox control (up to \$5,417), weed control (up to \$5,603), fencing important vegetation (up to \$5,556) and enhancement plantings (up to \$833).
